## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN JOSHIBI COLLEGE OF ART AND DESIGN AND SCHOOL OF VISUAL ARTS, LLC NEW YORK

This Articulation Agreement (the "Agreement") is made as of December 1, 2020 between the Joshibi College of Art and Design at the Joshibi University of Art and Design (hereinafter called "Joshibi"), an institution having its address at 1-49-8 Wada, Suginamiku, Tokyo 166-8538, JAPAN and School of Visual Arts, LLC (hereinafter called "SVA"), an institution having its address at 209 East 23 Street, New York, NY 10010-3994, U.S.A.

## WHEREAS

a) Joshibi students may seek fifth semester placement in the Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) program in Fine Arts or Design at SVA.

b) Both institutions are agreeable to the establishment of an Articulation Agreement upon the following conditions and areas of agreement.

#### 1.0 AREAS OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement is intended to outline a specific course of study for Joshibi students who may wish to transfer into fifth semester of the BFA Fine Arts or BFA Design programs at SVA, as follows:

1.1 Following the review of the Joshibi curriculum, SVA anticipates that Joshibi students who successfully complete the course of study for the Associates of Fine Arts program at Joshibi, as listed on the attached Course Comparison Chart, will be eligible to apply for transfer into the Bachelor of Fine Arts program in Fine Arts or Design at SVA and graduate within two additional years of full-time study.

1.2 Students must successfully complete all Joshibi courses listed on the attached Course Comparison Chart, which shows course equivalencies between Joshibi courses and SVA courses that satisfy BFA degree requirements at SVA.

1.3 To be exempted from first and second year studio courses, an applicant must submit a portfolio that demonstrates strong proficiency in the areas for which they are receiving transfer credit.

1.4 Entering students, whose first language is not English, must have received a minimum iBT TOEFL score of 80 (or a 6.5 IELTS score) to enter the BFA program.

1.5 Transfer placement of any student is contingent upon satisfactory review and approval by SVA's Admissions office and the Fine Arts or Design Department chair, in accordance with SVA's admissions process, of the student's application, including without limitation the student's portfolio and transfer credits.

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1.6 A total of 60 credits may be accepted in transfer. For BFA Design, 15 credits in humanities and sciences, 9 credits in art history and 36 credits in studio may be accepted. For Fine Arts, 12 credits in humanities and sciences, 12 credits in art history and 36 credits in studio may be accepted. Students would then be required to complete all remaining graduation requirements SVA.

This agreement is not intended to, and does not, create any binding obligations between the parties under the laws of any country of jurisdiction.

#### 2.0 CONDITIONS

This Agreement:

- 2.1 Will come into effect upon signature of the of Joshibi and the President of SVA;
- 2.2 Will apply for a period of five (5) years—December 1, 2020 to December 1, 2025 unless terminated earlier in accordance with 2.3 that follows;
- 2.3 May be terminated by either party giving to the other party no less than three (3) months notice in writing.

# 3.0 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY, GOVERNING LAW

In no event shall either party have liability to the other, or to any other person or entity, for any reason whatsoever under this Agreement. This Agreement shall be governed by the substantive laws of the State of New York, USA, without reference to it conflicts or law rules or any other law that might require the application of the substantive law of any other jurisdiction.
