

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
FAGSKOLEN KRISTIANIA
AND
SCHOOL OF VISUAL ARTS, INC.

This Articulation Agreement (the "Agreement") is made as of January 4th, 2024 between Fagskolen Kristiania (hereinafter called "Kristiania"), an institution having its address at Kirkegata 24-26, 0153 Oslo, NORWAY and School of Visual Arts, Inc. (hereinafter called "SVA"), a university having its address at 209 East 23 Street, New York, NY 10010-3994, U.S.A.

WHEREAS

- a) Kristiania students may seek fifth-semester placement in the Bachelor of Fine Arts program in Photography and Video at SVA.
- b) Both institutions are agreeable to the establishment of an Articulation Agreement upon the following conditions and areas of agreement.

1.0 AREAS OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement is intended to outline a specific course of study for Kristiania students who may wish to transfer into the fifth semester of the BFA Photography and Video program at SVA, as follows:

1.1 Students who have completed the Two-Year Photography Course at Kristiania, as outlined in the attached course comparison chart, will be eligible to apply for transfer into the Bachelor of Fine Arts program in Photography and Video at SVA. These students will begin their studies with a summer semester of Humanities & Sciences courses (6.0 credits) and proceed that fall into the fifth semester (third year) of the program, graduating in two years of full-time study.

1.2 Transfer placement (and the awarding of transfer credits) for any student is contingent upon satisfactory review and approval by SVA's Office of Admissions and the BFA Photography and Video Department chair, in accordance with SVA's application requirements, including but not limited to the student's portfolio, statement of intent, and official test scores.

1.3 To be exempted from first and second-year studio courses, an applicant must submit a portfolio that demonstrates strong proficiency in the areas for which they are receiving transfer credit.

1.4 A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 at Kristiania is required. Transfer credit will only be awarded for those courses in which students earn a grade of C or better.

1.5 Entering students, whose first language is not English, must have received a minimum iBT TOEFL score of 80 (or a 6.5 IELTS score) to enter the BFA program. Norwegian students who have attained fluency in English through documented upper-level coursework will qualify for a waiver of this requirement.

1.6 By completing the application requirements for this program, students are not guaranteed a place at SVA.

1.7 As enrollment capacity is limited at SVA, there is no guarantee as to the number of students who will be admitted under the parameters of this Agreement.

This agreement is not intended to, and does not, create any binding obligations between the parties under the laws of any country of jurisdiction.

2.0 CONDITIONS

This Agreement:

- 2.1 Will come into effect upon signature of the Head of Photography of Kristiania and the President of SVA;
- 2.2 Will apply for a period of five (5) years—January 4th, 2024 to January 4th, 2029 unless terminated earlier in accordance with 2.3 that follows;
- 2.3 May be terminated by either party giving to the other party no less than three (3) months' notice in writing.

3.0 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY, GOVERNING LAW

In no event shall either party have liability to the other, or to any other person or entity, for any reason whatsoever under this Agreement. This Agreement shall be governed by the substantive laws of the State of New York, USA, without reference to its conflicts or law rules or any other law that might require the application of the substantive law of any other jurisdiction.


