

School of Visual Arts Campus Hazing Transparency Report

Date of Report: December 15, 2025

The Stop Campus Hazing Act (SCHA), enacted in December 2024, requires institutions to create and distribute a Campus Hazing Transparency Report (CHTR, or “Report”) and to include hazing statistics in the Annual Security Report in accordance with the Clery Act.

School of Visual Arts (SVA) Hazing Policy & Procedure

The College’s hazing policy and its related policies and procedures are outlined in the SVA Handbook. This policy was adopted and published on June 23, 2025, and is reviewed each year.

SVA encourages prompt reporting of incidents of hazing and takes each report seriously. It will investigate all reports diligently and thoroughly, in accordance with the process outlined in the SVA Handbook. Any member of the SVA community may file a report of hazing using the online form (click to follow the link).

SVA will compile and publish relevant and pertinent information regarding each incident of hazing for which a recognized student organization was found responsible. Beginning July 1, 2025; this information will be collected and subsequently published (and updated) twice a year. This report and related statistics are available on SVA's website.

As of the date of this report, December 15, 2025, there are zero incidents of hazing to report.
