ENTRY

General admission only: Free for all current students, faculty, and staff with valid SVA ID. See below for detailed instructions on getting tickets.

Ticketed exhibitions: 40% discount on admission to special/ticketed exhibitions for current students, faculty, and staff with valid SVA ID. When you use the system to get tickets online, you will be able to see which exhibitions require special ticketed admission. See below for detailed instructions on getting tickets.

Students, faculty, and staff will need to show their SVA ID for entry.

TICKETING

Advance ticketing is strongly encouraged.

Current SVA students, faculty, and staff are entitled to redeem up to two (2) complimentary general admission tickets per visit.

Current SVA students, faculty, and staff are entitled to a 40% discount on up to two (2) special/ticketed exhibition tickets per visit.

STUDENTS

Via MoMA's community program for New York college students, SVA students receive one (1) free admission per visit to MoMA, as well as free film tickets at both museums. Tickets are available at the Ticketing Desk. A valid SVA ID must be shown.

STAFF AND FACULTY

ENTRY

Current SVA staff and faculty receive free, unlimited admission via SVA's Corporate Membership.

Visit the membership desk in the lobby and show your SVA ID for entry. Mention that SVA has a Corporate Membership if you have problems accessing the benefit.

TICKETING

Corporate Members and their guests must get tickets in person at the museum's membership desk.

GUESTS

Opportunity to purchase up to five (5) \$5 guest tickets per employee, per visit.

GROUP VISITS AND TOURS

Group visits: 10 – 50 visitors; defined as a group moving through the galleries together with no lecturing/guiding.

- Reserve [here](#).
- In order to take advantage of SVA's free admission, for "Is your employer a Corporate Member of the Museum?" select "Yes," and for Program Type, select "Discounted Group Admission only (a minimum of ten people required)."

Guided tours: A professional MoMA tour guide will lead these tours. Follow the instructions and reserve [here](#). Please confirm that MoMA is giving you the discount SVA receives through its Corporate Membership.

Free film tickets on the day of the event at both museums.

Daily 10% discount in MoMA stores. Present SVA ID at checkout.

Monthly 20% discount in MoMA stores and on store.moma.org (the discount code will be publicized in SVA Today on day of sale).

ENTRY

- Free admission for all current students, faculty, and staff
- Students, faculty, and staff will be asked to show their SVA ID and a government-issued ID for entry.

GUESTS

GROUP VISITS AND TOURS

- Group visits: Groups of six or more constitute a group visit. No lecturing in galleries.
 - Make arrangements in advance by emailing mpierce1@sva.edu, and include the following details:
 - Organizer's name and email address
 - Number of University Level membership tickets
 - Preferred date and time
- Self-guided tours: A limited number are available; contact Miranda Pierce at mpierce1@sva.edu for more information. Lecturing/guiding is allowed in the galleries. Maximum 20 guests (students and staff) per tour.

ENTRY

Free, unlimited admission for all current students, faculty, and staff

Students, faculty, and staff will be asked to show their SVA ID for entry.

TICKETING

Advance ticketing is encouraged.

Complimentary tickets can be pre-booked through the [Corporate Admission ticketing page](#).

- In the payment section, current students, faculty, and staff can enter the promo code "SVA2" in the "Have a Promo Code?" area to receive up to two (2) complimentary tickets. Any additional tickets will need to be purchased.
- Upon booking confirmation, tickets will be sent via email. Visitors must present their tickets at the museum to be scanned for entry.

Children under 18 can visit the museum for free.

GROUP VISITS AND TOURS

Two weeks' advance notice is recommended for scheduling group visits. Confirmation can take three to five days. Please plan accordingly.

Group visits are defined as 10 or more guests.

- SVA receives up to 25 complimentary tickets per group visit. Any additional tickets must be purchased at the discounted group rate (Adult \$25; Student/Senior \$20; 25 and under \$12).
- Groups larger than 25 may be required to stagger entry into the museum based on availability.

For group visits, lecturing in the galleries is not permitted.

For self-guided group visits, complete [this form](#).

- For "Group Description," select "University/College."
- For "Is your company a Whitney Corporate Member?," select "Yes."
- For "Corporate members at the Partner, Benefactor, or Patron level receive free employee admission. If you qualify for complimentary admission, select yes," select "Yes."
- For "Visit Type," select "Self-Guided Visit"

Note: Private guided tours led by a museum teaching fellow are available, but are not included in our membership. These tours are priced at \$250 for 25 guests. Instructors can work one-on-one with Teaching Fellows to develop a tour that engages with their course content. To request a private guided tour:
